## **Dunston Football Club History**

The club first saw the light of day in 1975 as a humble works outfit when former Chairman, John Thompson, with some of his colleagues at HMSO on the Team Valley Trading Estate, decided to form a football team. The club joined the Newcastle City Amateur League playing at the Civil Service Sports Ground, Longbenton.

Early success inspired the club to progress and a piece of land was leased from Gateshead M.B.C. and the committee began to develop what is now the UTS Stadium.

The club were now gaining much success in the Northern Combination and with aspirations to progress further they approached the Federation Brewery to become the club's main sponsor. With the Federation Brewery as their main sponsor the club joined the Wearside League in 1987 and after another period of success the club felt a need to seek new opportunities and an application was made to join the prestigious Northern League. The club had now realised one of its main ambitions and entered the National Pyramid of Non-League Football. In its second season in the Northern League the club won the Second Division and was promoted to the First Division.

Since joining the Northern League the club has won the Second Division, been First Division Champions twice, League Cup winners on five occasions and JR Cleator Cup winners on five occasions. Included in these successes were back to back First Division title winners and League Cup winners in seasons 2003/2004 and 2004/2005. A magnificent achievement.

Season 2007/2008 had seen the club lose the word Brewery from its name as sadly it lost the main sponsor. After a period of 18 years of continuous sponsorship the Federation Brewery was taken over by Scottish and Newcastle Breweries who continued to sponsor the club for a further two seasons and after a period of twenty years the club had lost its main sponsor and had no association with a brewery. In our hour of need two new companies became involved with the club to partially compensate for the loss of our main sponsor.

Dunston Van and Truck Centre became our home shirt sponsor and Astley Signs became our away shirt sponsor. Both companies are still with us at the present time. Season 2008/2009 a company, UTS Engineering (Utility Technology Services), became involved by sponsoring the player's travel and training kit and during the close season of 2009/2010 they kindly agreed to become the club's principal sponsor.

The club name was changed from Dunston Federation F.C. to Dunston UTS F.C, the name of the ground was changed to the UTS Stadium and company owner, Mr. Shaun Sadler became Club President.

On the 2nd April 2016 Dunston UTS celebrated their 1000th Northern League game. Prior to kick off on behalf of the club Malcolm James received an engraved plate from Northern League President George Courtney.

Building on the new-found momentum, Dunston continued in the same vein in the following season with a great run in the FA Cup, going out in the final Qualifying Round to National League neighbours Gateshead in front of a record crowd of 2,525 at the UTS Stadium.

The Club finished the 2018/2019 season as convincing Champions of the Northern League First Division, seventeen points ahead of their nearest rivals. Promotion ensued to the Northern Premier N/West Division but FA Regulations dictated that the Club Playing Name must not include any reference to a sponsor so the "UTS" was reluctantly dropped from the Club title before the new season.

Over the years the club has always recognised that success on the field must be coupled with success and hard work off the field and the efforts of the people behind the scenes at the UTS Stadium has ensured that the stadium is a credit to the club. Many of the committee of the club have been involved since it was founded in 1975, some as former players and some as management on the playing side.

It is a tribute to their commitment and hard work that the club has become one of the most successful in the North East.





## GATESHEAD FC - Player profiles

**Adam CAMERON – Goalkeeper** Cameron signed a one-year professional contract with the club in June 2021, following a season with Gateshead FC Academy's under-19 setup. The goalkeeper previously appeared for Sunderland's academy sides before making the switch to Tyneside.

**Sam GUTHRIE – Goalkeeper** Guthrie spent a period on trial with the Heed before signing on the dotted line in 2019, starting in the 4-2 win over Hebburn Town in pre-season. The North Shields-born stopper spent four years with Huddersfield Town before a one-month loan spell with Salford City in late 2014. Guthrie has also appeared for Clitheroe Town and played for Consett in Northern League Division One before making the move to the International Stadium. Guthrie re-signed for the 2020/21 season and has done so again ahead of the 2021/22 campaign.

**Kieren APLIN\* - Defender** Aplin joined the club in September 2020 after a successful trial period during pre-season. Adept in either defence or midfield, Aplin spent time as a scholar with Newcastle United until the age of 18 and has also appeared for Northern League Division One side North Shields. Aplin made one appearance during the 2020/21 season and re-signed with the club for the following campaign, before heading out on loan to Hebburn Town in June 2021.

**Ryan BOLTON – Defender** The Gateshead FC Academy defender joined the first-team setup having spent the 2020/21 season with the under-19 squad under the guidance of Ben Clark and Matty Pattison. The 19-year-old appeared for the first team during the club's 2020/21 pre-season schedule, and was included in the 18-man squad to face Farsley Celtic in last season's Buildbase FA Trophy. Bolton also appeared for Northern League Division Two side West Allotment Celtic prior to the cancellation of the 2020/21 season.

**Elliot FORBES – Defender** Gateshead College Graduate Elliot Forbes signed his first professional contract at the club in the summer of 2018 after impressing for the club's under-19s side and while on loan at Newcastle Benfield. Forbes returned to the Heed ahead of the 2019/20 season for his second season in professional football and made the successful transition to become a key part of Mike Williamson's defence. Forbes was one of a number to re-sign ahead of the 2021/22 season, following an injury-hit year which saw him limited to two appearances.

**Alex NICHOLSON – Defender** The full-back signed a one-year deal at the International Stadium in the summer of 2019 and arrived with National League North experience under his belt, having spent the 2018/19 season plying his trade at Croft Park.

The defender began his career in the youth setup at Newcastle United, before spells at Preston North End and Chorley preceded his initial spell at Blyth Spartans from 2014 to 2016. Nicholson made over 100 appearances for the club before joining South Shields in December 2016, where he went on to lift the FA Vase at Wembley Stadium in 2017. Nicholson was named Players' Player of the Season for the 2019/20 campaign for his consistent displays both at full-back and central defence, and made 16 appearances the following season before renewing his contract for the 2021/22 season.

**Louis STOREY – Defender** Storey, adept in both defence and midfield, arrived on a one-year deal from Hebburn Town in June 2021 and combines playing duties with a coaching role alongside Mike Williamson and Ian Watson. Storey captained the Hebburn Town squad during a hugely successful season for The Hornets, who lifted the 2019/20 Buildbase FA Vase in May and earned promotion from Northern League Division One. Storey spent time with Newcastle United's academy in his youth and made 72 appearances for South Shields prior to joining Hebburn in 2018, for whom he went on to appear 45 times, scoring seven goals.

**Robbie TINKLER – Defender** Tinkler re-joined the club for a third time in June 2021 following two spells during the 2017/18 and 2018/19 seasons, making a total of 65 appearances and scoring two goals. Tinkler spent the 2019/20 season with National League side Aldershot Town, before linking up with former Gateshead manager Steve Watson at York City the following season.

**Ryan WOMBWELL – Defender** Wombwell arrived in June 2021 on a two-year contract, having made 15 appearances for Sunderland U23's during the 2020/21 season. Wombwell first appeared for The Black Cats' U18 setup in March 2019, making 25 appearances across two seasons before progressing to the club's U23 side.

**Mike WILLIAMSON – Defender/Player-Manager** A familiar name to those on Tyneside, experienced centre-back Mike Williamson returned to the north east to sign for Gateshead in the summer of 2018, three years after leaving Premier League side and cross river neighbours Newcastle United.

The Stoke-born defender amassed over 130 top-flight appearances for the Magpies over a six year spell and was part of Alan Pardew's side who claimed a surprise fifth-place finish in 2011/12.

Prior to his spell at Newcastle, Williamson made just shy of 200 appearances for Football League sides Torquay United, Wycombe Wanderers and Watford. The 6ft 4in defender has earned three promotions as a player, most recently with United, as they claimed the 2009/10 Championship title.

Since leaving Newcastle with 170 appearances and two goals to his name, Williamson spent two seasons at Wolverhampton Wanderers in the Championship before moving to League One side Oxford United last season, making 17 appearances in all competitions.

After leaving Oxford, Williamson joined up to train with the Heed in pre-season before being offered a contract at the club soon after. In January 2019, Williamson was named as an official player-coach as part of new Heed manager Ben Clark's coaching team.

The defender was named as the club's player-manager in the summer of 2019, returning with Ian Watson as his assistant. Williamson guided the club to the National League North play-off semi-final in his first season in charge, and had his side within reach of the play-off places prior to the cancellation of the following season.

**Danny GREENFIELD – Midfielder** Greenfield joined the Heed on a one-year deal in July 2019 after a successful trial period with the club.

The midfielder impressed during pre-season appearances against Consett and Hebburn Town which led to player-manager Mike Williamson handing the youngster a first-team contract. The teenager spent time with Manchester United up to under-13 level before joining Barnsley, who he remained with until the summer of 2019 as an academy player. Greenfield made 13 appearances during the 2020/21 season following a loan spell at Matlock Town, and re-signed for the 2021/22 campaign.

**Jack HUNTER – Midfielder** Hunter joined The Heed for the second time in his career in the summer of 2020, ahead of the 2020/21 season.

The midfielder first arrived at the International Stadium ahead of the 2018/19 season after leaving Newcastle United, and played a part in guiding Ben Clark's side to a top-half finish before an enforced demotion.

Hunter spent the 2019/20 season with neighbours Blyth Spartans, making 31 appearances and scoring once across all competitions. He made 14 appearances in Gateshead colours during the 2020/21 season and was one of a number to re-sign ahead of the 2021/22 campaign.

**Greg OLLEY – Midfielder** Attacking midfielder Greg Olley signed for the Heed after a successful trial in 2018/19 which saw him score five goals in one and a half matches.

Immediately after netting twice against Newcastle Benfield at the International Stadium, the former Newcastle United youngster signed a one-year deal at the Club.

After leaving Newcastle's Academy, Olley joined Hull City where he would go on to make his professional debut in a 3-1 League Cup victory over Exeter City, playing the full 90-minutes.

The following season he would make his second senior appearance for the Tigers, as they were beaten 2-0 by Doncaster Rovers in the League Cup.

The midfielder then agreed a new one-year deal with the club in July 2019, recording a club-leading tally of 15 assists as well as netting seven goals during the 2019/20 season.

Olley made 16 appearances during the 2020/21 season and signed on for a fourth season on Tyneside ahead of the following campaign.

**Connor PANI – Midfielder** The midfielder put pen to paper on a two-year contract with the club in July 2021 following a spell with Gateshead FC Academy.

Pani made a number of pre-season appearances ahead of the 2021/22 season – one that will be his first in professional football.

**Dan WARD – Midfielder** Ward joined The Heed on a one-year deal in October 2020.

Ward spent the first half of the 2019/20 with local rivals Spennymoor Town after departing Middlesbrough in 2019, making 16 appearances before returning to full-time football with Irish Premier Division outfit St. Patrick's Athletic. The midfielder went on to make seven appearances for St Pats before the season was curtailed, and he joined Gateshead ahead of the 2020/21 season, going on to make nine appearances. Ward was one of a number of players to re-sign with the club for the 2021/22 season.

**Paul BLACKETT – Forward** Signed with the Heed after spending time on trial with the club in pre-season of 2019/20 and appeared as a substitute in the pre-season opener against Middlesbrough.

Blackett is a product of Newcastle United's academy setup and also spent time with Sheffield United as a youngster before returning to the North-East with Heaton Stannington and Newcastle Benfield.

The forward re-signed ahead of the 2020/21 campaign and spent the early portion of the season on loan with Blyth Spartans, scoring six goals in 10 games before being recalled, although the season was curtailed shortly afterwards. Blackett signed a one-year deal ahead of the 2021/22 season.

**Adam CAMPBELL – Forward** penned a deal on Tyneside until the end of the 2021/22 season in May 2021.

The 26-year-old originally joined on loan from Newcastle United in January 2015, scoring three goals in eight National League appearances.

Campbell has made over 100 appearances in the Football League with Notts County, Morecambe & Carlisle United and most recently spent two seasons at Darlington where he scored 22 goals in 60 appearances.

**Nelson OGBEWE\* - Forward** The striker signed his first professional contract with the club over the summer and is currently on loan at neighbours Hebburn Town. He spent the 2020/21 season playing within the club's academy system and scored against Stockton Town and Eccleshill United in the FA Youth Cup. Ogbewe made one first team appearances last season, coming off the bench in a 3-2 FA Trophy defeat against Farsley Celtic.

**Macaulay LANGSTAFF – Forward** Macaulay Langstaff made the move to Tyneside for the second time in his career in August 2020, having first signed for the club from Billingham Synthonia in February 2017.

Langstaff made five National League appearances during the 2017/18 season and was sent out on loan to Billingham Synthonia and Blyth Spartans before departing Gateshead for York at the season's culmination.

The forward had a brief second loan spell with Blyth last season, and also appeared for Bradford (Park Avenue) on loan in the second half of the 2018/2019 season. Langstaff scored four goals in 16 appearances during the 2020/21 season and signed a one-year contract extension ahead of the 2021/22 campaign.

**Cedwyn SCOTT – Forward** The striker arrived having spent the latter half of the 2020/21 season with EFL League Two side Carlisle United, where he made seven substitute appearances.

Scott enjoyed a rich vein of goalscoring form in the early part of last season with Northern League Division One side Hebburn Town, scoring 22 goals in 17 appearances across all competitions.

Scott previously appeared for Dunston UTS following spells with Scottish clubs Dundee, Berwick Rangers and Forfar Athletic.

## Player Interview – Michael Pearson

In this interview we talk to Dunston UTS FC's midfielder dynamo Michael Pearson as he makes his recovery back from the injury that has kept him out of action since pre-season 2020/21.

Having joined Dunston UTS FC back in 2015, he has gone on to become a solid, reliable and hardworking midfielder. With over 100 appearances for the club, he was influential in Dunston UTS FC's Northern League title win in the 2018/19 season. Having sustain an injury away to Newcastle Benfield during pre-season, we catch up with the player as he makes his recovery.

**You've been out since pre-season with the injury you picked up away to Newcastle Benfield. How frustrating has it been for you not being able to play?**

It's been really frustrating! Especially when the lads were still playing and I was watching from the side-line, not able to do anything that has got to be the worst feeling in football.



**The last two seasons before this one, Dunston UTS FC have gone on some impressive runs in The FA Cup. The 2018/19 seen us face Gateshead in the 4th qualifying round in front of over 2,500 fans, in what was an outstanding season, that must have been some experience as a player, the match live on TV, a load of build-up in the press. The F.A. Cup is still massive, particularly for clubs and players at this level. How does that game rank as one of the biggest games of your career?**

That's right up there! I think that season as a whole was incredible but that cup run was something else, we played teams from higher leagues just about every round and had some really good wins on the way to that Gateshead game.

I remember the Chester game being a bit of a thriller that we managed to win 4-3 if I remember correctly. The buzz grew after every round and then when we drew Gateshead, I think that was the game everyone wanted. It was a massive game for the area and there was a real buzz about the place! Even though we ended up getting beat I still have fond memories of the day and that was one of the best occasions I have been involved in in football.

**A lot of that was down to the partnership you and Jake Stafford formed in the middle of the park. I remember when Swaz came in and you were playing full back but over the last few seasons you've developed into a solid central midfielder, made the position your own and become a key player for Dunston. How much do you think you've developed in that time?**

We have always had a good team mentality and everyone is willing to work hard for one another, which for me has been the key to our success and is the way Dunston have been for a number of years. It's something I always make sure I do and I pride myself on giving 100% effort always.

I think Jake and I did have good partnership that season, I think we definitely bring the best out of each other and again I put that mainly just down to hard work.

In terms of my own development I think I have definitely enjoyed the move from fullback to midfield and enjoy being able to get involved more in the game and I think I'm a better player for that, basically as long as it doesn't involve shooting, I'll do a job anywhere.



**The 2019/19 season Dunston UTS FC won The League title by 17 points, an amazing achievement, what made that season the success that it was?**

That season was probably the best season I've ever been involved with in non-league football, to win a league as competitive as The Northern League by 17 points just goes to show what an achievement it was! I think it was all down to how good the team spirit was that season and we are all good mates on and off the pitch. The wins on the pitch and the nights out were equally good and it was a pleasure to be a part of! The highlight of the season being the FA cup run and the buzz around the place and being the talk of the town. And it was incredible to play in front of the 2500 people that turned out to watch and even though we got beat by Gateshead that was one of the most enjoyable days I've had at Dunston!

**On the Coach back from games, who is the worst player to get control of the music selection and best back of the bus DJ?**

Well it's normally Scrappy (Liam Thear) in control of the tunes and I think he does a pretty good job. Fitzy (Mark Fitzpatrick) likes to get the rave on, which I don't mind and I know the committee are big fans of that as well, but that's basically the only two that really step up.
