Dunston Football Club History

The club first saw the light of day in 1975 as a humble works outfit when former Chairman, John Thompson, with some of his colleagues at HMSO on the Team Valley Trading Estate, decided to form a football team. The club joined the Newcastle City Amateur League playing at the Civil Service Sports Ground, Longbenton.

Early success inspired the club to progress and a piece of land was leased from Gateshead M.B.C. and the committee began to develop what is now the UTS Stadium.

The club were now gaining much success in the Northern Combination and with aspirations to progress further they approached the Federation Brewery to become the club's main sponsor. With the Federation Brewery as their main sponsor the club joined the Wearside League in 1987 and after another period of success the club felt a need to seek new opportunities and an application was made to join the prestigious Northern League. The club had now realised one of its main ambitions and entered the National Pyramid of Non-League Football. In its second season in the Northern League the club won the Second Division and was promoted to the First Division.

Since joining the Northern League the club has won the Second Division, been First Division Champions twice, League Cup winners on five occasions and JR Cleator Cup winners on five occasions. Included in these successes were back to back First Division title winners and League Cup winners in seasons 2003/2004 and 2004/2005. A magnificent achievement.

Season 2007/2008 had seen the club lose the word Brewery from its name as sadly it lost the main sponsor. After a period of 18 years of continuous sponsorship the Federation Brewery was taken over by Scottish and Newcastle Breweries who continued to sponsor the club for a further two seasons and after a period of twenty years the club had lost its main sponsor and had no association with a brewery. In our hour of need two new companies became involved with the club to partially compensate for the loss of our main sponsor.

Dunston Van and Truck Centre became our home shirt sponsor and Astley Signs became our away shirt sponsor. Both companies are still with us at the present time. Season 2008/2009 a company, UTS Engineering (Utility Technology Services), became involved by sponsoring the player's travel and training kit and during the close season of 2009/2010 they kindly agreed to become the club's principal sponsor. The club name was changed from Dunston Federation F.C. to Dunston UTS F.C., the name of the ground was changed to the UTS Stadium and company owner, Mr. Shaun Sadler became Club President.

On the 2nd April 2016 Dunston UTS celebrated their 1000th Northern League game. Prior to kick off on behalf of the club Malcolm James received an engraved plate from Northern League President George Courtney.

Building on the new-found momentum, Dunston continued in the same vein in the following season with a great run in the FA Cup, going out in the final Qualifying Round to National League neighbours Gateshead in front of a record crowd of 2,525 at the UTS Stadium.

The Club finished the 2018/2019 season as convincing Champions of the Northern League First Division, seventeen points ahead of their nearest rivals. Promotion ensued to the Northern Premier N/West Division but FA Regulations dictated that the Club Playing Name must not include any reference to a sponsor so the "UTS" was reluctantly dropped from the Club title before the new season.

Over the years the club has always recognised that success on the field must be coupled with success and hard work off the field and the efforts of the people behind the scenes at the UTS Stadium has ensured that the stadium is a credit to the club. Many of the committee of the club have been involved since it was founded in 1975, some as former players and some as management on the playing side.

It is a tribute to their commitment and hard work that the club has become one of the most successful in the North East.

Dunston UTS FC welcomed near neighbours Gateshead FC to the UTS Stadium for their opening game of pre-season.

Going into the game “The Heed” were already 2 games into pre-season, with 2 wins from 2 against Hebburn Town and Billingham Town respectively, whilst the hosts start to pre-season had been delayed due to Sunderland RCA having to withdraw from last Saturdays planned opener. With the exciting signings Phil Turnbull and Craig Baxter, along with the addition of forward Lee Mason, there is a belief amongst many this season that should see Dunston pushing for promotion.

With all three making their debuts, along with a few trialists, Dunston put on a good performance in front of a crowd of 464, however it would be the visitors who’d leave with the win.

Former Dunston man Cedwyn Scott opened the scoring for Gateshead on 16 minutes, drilling his shot low past Connell from inside the box.

Dunston levelled 4 minutes later through trialist, a sweetly caught volley at the back post, from a superb Luke Porritt delivery, lashed beyond the reach of Gateshead keeper Adam Cameron.

Dunston’s defence had looked composed and organised throughout the first half, limiting Gateshead to a few half chances. With the scores level at half-time, the visitors opted to make several changes. Substitute Ed Thomas putting Gateshead ahead on 67, intercepting a loose ball to slot past Connell.

Michael Hall prevented Gateshead from extending their lead moments later, his strength and intelligent reading of the threat used to great effect as a Gateshead forward bore down on goal.

The hosts had the better opportunities of the last 10 minutes, Luke Porritt creating a fine chance playing Ryan Leonard in only for him to drag the chance to equalise narrowly wide of the post

That chance seemed to spur Dunston on, a corner moments later delivered in by Porritt, saw Galbraith rising supremely above the Gateshead defence, only to see his powerfully headed effort cannon against the crossbar.

Speaking Chris Swailes after the game “I had a few missing tonight, but performance wise I thought we created some good chances to get something from the game” he continued “Gateshead are a full-time side, and obviously they’ve had a few games already, but I wanted to start the season off with a win, friendly or not, it all comes down to winning games”.

Chris Swales has yet again added further quality to his side ahead of the 2021/22 season with the signing of 25 year old midfielder Luke Porritt.



Having recently moved to the North East and trained with the club during pre-season, Swaz has wasted no time in securing Porritt's signature following an impressive display against Gateshead FC on Tuesday night.

Up until last season, Porritt had been with Northern Premier League side Scarborough Athletic, although his time there had been hampered by injury, he was highly thought of by Supporter's. Previous to that he had been with Hyde United, where again, his attitude and ability had earned him the respect and admiration of those at the Club. Starting out as a youngster at Guiseley, he has had loan spells with Frickley and Ossett Albion.

Dunston UTS FC Manager Chris Swales had this to say on his latest signing: *"Luke's a quality player and has played at a higher level. He's a real threat, he's direct, uses the ball well and can play in all positions across the front"*.

With Assistant Manager Jon McDonald adding *"Luke has a good pedigree, having played higher up the pyramid for a number of clubs. Club History

Morpeth Town Football Club was established in 1894, and through more than a century of football have continued the tradition of carrying Amber and Black as their team colours.

The club was formed after an amalgamation between Morpeth United and Morpeth FC, playing at Stobhill Cricket Field.

In 1954 the club moved to Storey Park, and in the 1980's enjoyed a successful time in the Northern Alliance, winning the title and finishing runners-up on two other occasions, as well as lifting both the Challenge Cup and Benevolent Bowl in 1986.

The club spent half a century in the Northern Football Alliance before stepping up to the Northern League on their one hundredth anniversary, winning the Division Two title in their first season and finishing sixth in Division One and Northumberland Senior Cup runners-up in their second. In 1998-99 they made it to the final qualifying round of the FA Cup, losing 1-0 at home to Nigel Clough's Burton Albion.

The club moved to a purpose built stadium in 1994, which co-incided with a League and Cup double, and with it, promotion to the Northern League. Craik Park was named after the father and son W and R Craik who had served as secretary between 1920 and 1985. Current President Ken Beattie was the man behind the stadium and since 1992 he has revived the club's fortunes.

Membership of the Northern League followed in 1994/95 and the following year saw the Second Division Championship being presented to Morpeth. The club finished 6th in the First Division at the first time of asking, as well as reaching the final of the Northumberland Senior Cup.

After sitting comfortably mid-table between 1996/7 and 1999/2000, Morpeth narrowly avoided relegation on goal difference in the 2000/01 season, and finished once again one spot above the relegation zone in 2001/02.

The next few years saw Morpeth Town move back into the middle of the table before a 6th place finish in 2005/06, Morpeth's equal top performance in the Northern League.

In 2006/07 Morpeth won the Northumberland Senior Cup for the first time since 1886 (as Morpeth Harriers) with a 3-2 victory over Blyth Spartans.

Disaster struck in 2009/10 as Morpeth Town were relegated to the second division and things got even worse a season later as Morpeth Town finished bottom of the Northern League's second tier.

The club was in dire straits with President Ken Beattie and Chairman Jim Smith trying their best to keep the club running by bringing the ground up to Northern League standards whilst being forced to ground share with local rivals Bedlington Terriers. The club was within weeks of folding at one point.

The Highwaymen began their revival in 2011/12 under the stewardship of Nick Gray who moved to the club from Seaton Delaval and brought a number of players. In his first season Morpeth narrowly avoided promotion back to the top tier, finishing fourth and a one point won fourteen consecutive home games.

2012/13 saw the side improve once more, finishing one place higher in third position, beating out Jarrow Roofing on goal difference to earn promotion.

After earning promotion Morpeth Town managed to avoid the drop quite comfortably finishing in 17th place. During the season they also went on a historic FA Vase run to the Quarter-Final stage.

In 2014/15 saw further improvement, with the Highwaymen finishing 8th in the table and reaching the Northumberland Senior Cup Final.
